

## **Mission Statement**

College Avenue Baptist Church – CAVBC-Medicine Ministry is a nonprofit charitable organization, chartered by the state of Texas. CAVBC-Medicine Ministry was founded in March of 2008 by Rev. and Mrs. Thien-An N. Dang (advisor pastor for College Avenue Vietnamese Baptist Church – the Mission church of College Avenue Baptist Church of Fort Worth, Texas.)

The unique mission and purpose of CAVBC-Medicine Ministry is to assist and distribute medicines to nonprofit organizations that have medical missions at home or abroad.

CAVBC-Medicine Ministry is governed by eight-member board of directors of College Avenue Vietnamese Baptist Church, Fort Worth, Texas. There are 7 volunteer staff members of CAVBC-Medicine Ministry, which does not include College Avenue Baptist Church congregation, College Avenue Vietnamese Baptist Church congregation, or all the different volunteers from the DFW area.

According to CAVBC-Medicine Ministry, the majority of monetary contribution given to CAVBC-Medicine Ministry comes from “churches support.” All contributions go into expenditures of the medicine program. CAVBC-Medicine Ministry’ monthly expenditures average approximately \$1,000. The CAVBC-Medicine Ministry accounting book establishes a clear and readiness for auditing either by the IRS, the eight-member board of directors, or all other organizations related to CAVBC-Medicine Ministry.

Because CAVBC-Medicine Ministry is under a 501 (C)(3) of Baptist General Convention of Texas, all contributions are tax-deductible.
